Building Improvement

When our windows get cloudy because of a broken seal, they can be taken to True Value Hardware in Wayne. For an approximate 31 x 26" window the cost to repair is \$75.00.

Remove window and frame from track, take in to hardware store. They measure the glass and write up the order to replace the glass, be sure to request they must replace with the cross pane markings. You put back your window and wait for the repair pane to come in. The repair company creates the new pane as ordered and it is returned to the store completely sealed with the thermo gas. You take in your old window, they exchange out the old glass for the new sealed glass and then recycle your old glass with the repair company.

Trash Pickup Reminder

WOCV Association regulations state residents must place garbage at approved locations no earlier than 6:00pm the day before trash collection. Residents must remove all garbage, yard waste, and recyclables containers from sight by the end of the day on each garbage collection day. Each time that trash containers are not removed from sight by the end of garbage day shall constitute a separate violation, and fines or other penalties may be imposed by the Board for such violations.

The lawn company needs access to all areas of the property whether they are doing spring cleanup or mowing the lawns. When placing your garbage cans out on collection day, do not put cans or trash on the grass. The proper location is at the end of each drive along the curb so as not to block access to or from garage drives.

CARDBOARD BOXES: Flattened cardboard must be cut into pieces no larger than 36" squares and either placed in the recycling bin or next to the recycling bin in a clear plastic bag, or bundled weighing no more than 50lbs. No commercially produced cardboard is accepted. If you don't want to prepare the cardboard this way it can be recycled by taking it to CWR during any Canton Township scheduled Clean-up.
