REMINDERS-

Parking- Vehicles believed to be parked in a shared community spot continuously (i.e., without being moved) for more than 72 hours will be tagged with a violation sticker. Vehicles are subject to being towed between 48 – 72 after the violation sticker is placed on the vehicle.

CALCIUM CHLORIDE BUCKETS - the plastic 2.5 Gallon Calcium Chloride Buckets with lid have been provided to you from the Association to assist in any icy conditions that you may find on your sidewalk or in front of your garage. Provided as a one-time courtesy, the bucket is your responsibility to maintain and replace if damaged, broken or lost. The bucket must remain a part of the unit should you sell or move. Also, it will be your responsibility to replace the contents with only a calcium chloride product, as it has been proven to be effective, yet minimize damage to lawns and concrete.

Canton Township Trash Pickup

REFUSE CONTAINERS: MUST BE 32 GALLONS or less. Refuse cans must be made of metal or plastic with two handles and a tight fitting cover. No single receptacle or bag shall weigh more than 50 pounds when lifted. No cardboard boxes or paper bags can be used as containers for refuse.

CARDBOARD BOXES: Flattened cardboard must be cut into pieces no larger than 36” squares and either placed in the recycling bin or next to the recycling bin in a clear plastic bag, or bundled weighing no more than 50lbs. No commercially produced cardboard is accepted. If you don't want to prepare the cardboard this way it can be recycled by taking it to CWR during any Canton Township scheduled Clean-up.

WOCV Association regulations state residents must place garbage at approved locations no earlier than 6:00pm the day before trash collection. Residents must remove all garbage, yard waste, and recyclables containers from sight by the end of the day on each garbage collection day. Each time that trash containers are not removed from sight by the end of garbage day shall constitute a separate violation, and fines or other penalties may be imposed by the Board for such violations.
