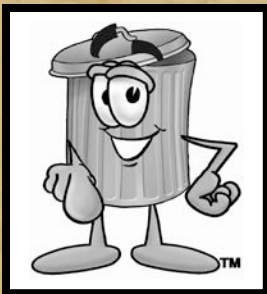
Grilling reminder – due to the risk of carbon monoxide poisoning WOCV does not permit the use of charcoal grills.

National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day – Canton Police Department will be participating in the National DEA Prescription Take-Back Day. On Saturday, April 30, from 10am to 2pm, the Canton Police Department will take part in a national collaborative effort with the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) to remove potentially dangerous prescription drugs from homes in our community. This national take-back initiative will provide a unified opportunity for the public to turn in expired, unused and unwanted prescription medications to law enforcement for destruction. Unused or expired prescription medications may be placed in a drop box located in the lobby of the Canton Police Department, 1150 S. Canton Center Road. Pills only will be accepted. Liquids and needles will not be accepted. Prescription drugs can only be accepted by the department during the established program hours. Trash Pickup-WOCV Association regulations state residents must use a labeled trash container. Due to the wildlife, bags of garbage must be in a trash container.



Place garbage at approved locations no earlier than 6:00pm the evening before trash collection.

Residents must remove all trash containers, yard waste, and recyclables containers from sight by the end of the day on each garbage collection day.

A separate violation could result each time trash containers, etc. are not removed from sight by the end of garbage day.
