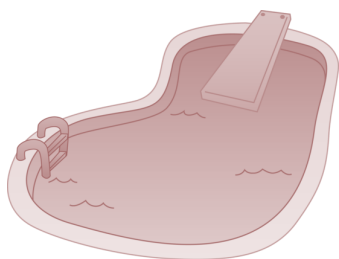


Community Pool Rules and Safety

The Pool Opens Memorial Day Weekend - Know the Rules and Be Safe!



Pool season at WOCV opens on Memorial Day weekend. As the season approaches, it is important to be aware of our community's pool usage rules, and more importantly, to be aware of pool and water safety. The following is a summary of the WOCV pool rules and pool safety protocols.

POOL RULES

1. The pool is available for use by any Association Member that is in good standing with the Association.
2. The pool is open from 9AM to 9PM Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend.
3. Pool access is by keycard. Residents should not grant access to anyone who does not have a working keycard.
4. A hosting co-owner/renter adult must accompany guests using the pool. Guests are limited to 5 per unit; including co-owners/renters renting the clubhouse.
5. Any damage caused by a co-owner or guest will be assessed to the co-owner.
6. Residents shall have the use of the pool when the Clubhouse is reserved.
7. Individuals who violate the rules, exhibit poor conduct or fail to show evidence of their rights to use the facility may be dismissed from the pool area.
8. The Board may suspend an individual's pool privileges temporarily or permanently in cases of flagrant or continued violation of rules.
9. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.
10. Alcoholic beverages of any kind are strictly prohibited in the pool area.
11. No food may be brought into the pool enclosure.
12. In consideration of the residents living in proximity of the pool, amplified sound equipment is not to be used in the pool area.
13. Persons under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants will be denied access to the pool area.

POOL & WATER SAFETY

1. Children 12 and under, non-swimmers, or others unlikely to exercise mature judgment in health and safety matters, are not permitted to enter the pool area unless accompanied by a resident adult charged with the responsibility for their safety and conduct.
2. Floating devices or other objects, which may pose a hazard or hinder efficient use of the pool will not be permitted.
3. Running, boisterous or rough play, ball throwing, diving or other accident prone and disruptive activities are not permitted.
4. Glass containers of any kind are not permitted within the enclosure area.

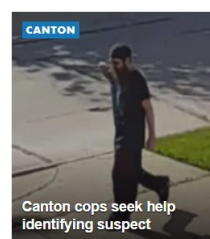

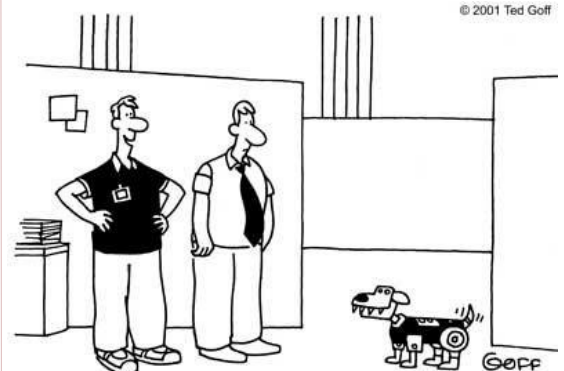
