BASKETBALL COURT REGULATIONS

ALL RESIDENTS AND GUESTS USING THE BASKETBALL COURTS INCUR A CERTAIN RISK. NEITHER THE BUILDER/DEVELOPER, ASSOCIATION CORPORATION, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR THE MANAGEMENT COMPANY SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT, LOSS OR INJURY IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH USE EXCEPT AS MAY BE DETERMINED IN A COURT OF LAW.

The basketball courts are open and available for use from dawn to dusk. There must be at least one Association Member participating in the game.

Sign-up times can be arranged to assure court time reservations. Reserved court times must be met within ten minutes following the scheduled reservation or the time is forfeited to avoid interference with the next scheduled party.

We ask that all Association Members obey the following rules and guidelines to ensure the safety and consideration of all participants and spectators. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations may result in fines or loss of privileges or both. The court area and backboards/nets are supplied by the Association. All other equipment must be supplied by the Member. Any damage to the court area and/or equipment will be the responsibility of the Member reserving the court during the time any damage was incurred.

- 1) Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. No hard-soled shoes or spiked shoes are permitted on the court.
- 2) Court reservations are limited to two hours.
- 3) The basketball courts are to be used for basketball only.
- 4) No pets are allowed within the basketball court enclosure.
- 5) No glass containers of any kind are allowed within the basketball court enclosure.

Please be considerate of fellow Association Members who also wish to use the basketball courts. When leaving the basketball courts, take any belongings with you and deposit any trash in appropriate receptacles.
